Ada later returned to the parish, where she was employed as a general servant by William JOHNSON. She married Frederick William WELLS in 1900 and moved to Daventry. Ada died in Daventry in 1941 at the age of 69.

The daughter of the Reverend Simon and Elizabeth ADAMS (née KNIGHTLEY), Elizabeth was born in Oxford in 1695/96 and came to Preston Capes with her mother, after the death of her father in 1701. She moved to Litchborough upon her mother's re-marriage to Samuel LEEKE and lived there until her mother's death in 1737 when she moved to her uncle's, the Reverend Samuel ADAMS, at Alvescot, Oxon. Elizabeth died at the age of 69 and was buried beside her mother in the nave of the church at Preston Capes on 17 Aug 1765.

Here lies the body of Mrs Elizabeth LEEKE, the wife of Samuel LEEKE Esq of Litchborough; she was the daughter of the Reverend Mr Richard KNIGHTLEY, Rector of Byfield & Charwelton & Prebendary of Durham. She was first married to the Reverend Mr Simon ADAMS of Oxford; by whom she has 3 children; Elizabeth, Sarah & Knightley ADAMS, Rector of this Parish. She died 17 November 1737, aged 71. On each side of their mother lie her two daughters. The eldest died unmarried 17th August 1765 aged 69. The youngest was married to the Reverend Mr Digby COTES, Vicar of Coleshill in the County of Warwick, Principal of Magdelene Hall and Public Orator in the University of Oxford. She died 3rd of April 1767 aged 70

She left the parish upon her marriage to Thomas RODWELL of St Martin in the Field, Middx, by licence at Preston Capes on 9 Jun 1778. Elizabeth died at the age of 39 and was buried in the churchyard at Preston Capes on 13 May 1783.

ADAMS, Elizabeth

1796/97-1851

The daughter of William ADAMS of Everdon, Elizabeth was born in 1796/97 and married Daniel HAYNES, a blacksmith about 1810 when they moved to Eydon. They came to Preston Capes about 1817. After the death of her husband in 1844, Elizabeth, with her daughter-in-law Hannah HAYNES and grandson Daniel, was the subject of a removal order by the Overseers of the Poor for Preston Capes to Priors Marston, Warks. The Overseers for Priors Marston appealed against the order claiming that they belonged to Priors Hardwick, but to save costs agreed to take them on 14 Oct 1845. Elizabeth died in 1851.

The daughter of William and Alice ADAMS (née ENGLAND), Hannah was born at Lilbourne and baptised at the parish church there on 15 Feb 1818. They moved to Fawsley when she married William HAYNES at Preston Capes on 19 Oct 1837. After her husband's death, Hannah, her son Daniel and her mother-in-law, Elizabeth HAYNES, were the subjects of a removal order by the Overseers of the Poor for Preston Capes, dated 1844, to Priors Marston, Warks. The Overseers for Priors Marston appealed against the order claiming that they belonged to Priors Hardwick, but to save

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costs agreed to take them on 14 Oct 1845. However they moved back to Fawsley where she lived with her parents. Hannah died in 1857 and was buried at Watford on 29 Nov.

- £50 of 3% stock of the Bank of England to Bernard Geary SNOW, surgeon, of Southam, Warks as a mark of her regard for him
- 5 guineas to the Reverend Holford COTTON of Adderbury, Oxon as a token of their friendship
- the residue to be held in trust by the Reverend Holford COTTON and her son Thomas VYNER for the absolute benefit of her daughter Delicia HAYWARD during the life of her husband James Robinson HAYWARD
- in case her daughter Delicia HAYWARD survive her husband then all trust money should be paid to her
- in case her son-in-law James Robinson HAYWARD survive her daughter then he should receive the interest and dividends from the trust for the rest of his natural life and after his death then the trust money should be divided equally between the surviving children of her daughter Delicia HAYWARD and if she have no surviving children then the trust money should be equally divided between her sons Thomas and Robert VYNER
- that the Reverend Holford COTTON and her son Thomas VYNER be joint executors of her estate

ADAMS, Knightley

1698-1769

The son of the Reverend Simon and Elizabeth ADAMS (née KNIGHTLEY), Knightley was baptised at Charwelton on 15 Sep 1698 and came to Preston Capes with his mother from Oxford after his father died in 1701. He moved to Litchborough with his mother about 1710. Knightley enrolled at Hart Hall, Oxford University on 21 Mar 1714 and was awarded a B.A. degree in 1719 and an M.A. in 1721. He was appointed a deacon at Christ Church Cathedral, Oxford on 20 May 1722 and presented on 9 Jun 1723. He was instituted as Rector of Preston Capes on 4 Mar 1723 being presented by Sir John

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CREW, Robert HARLEY, Thomas FOLEY, John SCROPE and Francis GASTRELL, Bishop of Chester. Knightley married Jane NEWTON of Lavendon Grange, Bucks on 27 Aug 1724 at Cold Brayfield, Bucks. Knightley exercised his vote in the County Elections of Jun 1730 when he voted for Sir Justinian ISHAM and Apr 1748 when he voted for Sir Valentine KNIGHTLEY. He died on 12 Nov 1769 at the age of 71 and was buried in the chancel of the church on 16 Nov.
