The son of the Reverend Thomas DANBY, Vicar of Keighley, Yorks, Thomas was baptised at Keighley on 8 Mar 1660 and went to school in Bingley, Yorks. He matriculated at Christ's College, Cambridge on 23 Sep 1674 and was awarded his B.A. degree in 1678. Thomas became a deacon in Mar 1681 and was ordained at York on 24 Feb 1683.
