Harriet, his wife, died in early 1868 and he married his second wife, Amelia BUCKNILL at Market Bosworth in 1870. Thomas was instituted as Rector of Farthingstone on 13 May 1873 where, besides his clerical duties, he was farmer of the Glebe land of 180 acres. They moved to Maidford on 12 Apr 1888 but his wife died a year later. Thomas married his third wife, Mary Beatrice BRADLEY, in 1896. On 8 Oct 1898, he was appointed Rector of Preston Capes, a position he held until his death on 20 Dec 1915. He was buried at Rhayader, Radnor on 23 Dec. Children:
