She moved with her parents to Geddington in 1883 and Kettering in 1891 and upon leaving school came to Preston Capes where she worked as a domestic for Thomas HICKMAN at The Swan. Ada moved to Blackburn, Lancs where she worked as a sick nurse and moved back to Daventry in 1915 where she studied to be a State Registered Nurse. Ada moved to Preston Capes in 1929. She died at Daventry Hospital on 17 Sep 1945 at the age of 65 and was buried in the churchyard on 20 Sep.

The son of Thomas and Catherine INNS (previously SMITH née WILLS), Charles was born on 3 Dec 1858 and baptised at Preston Capes on 23 Jan 1859. He worked as a farm labourer and left the

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village about 1880 to work as a milkman at Priors Marston returning about 1885. Charles married Maria Jane PARKER in 1899. His wife died in 1901 as a result of giving birth to the twins and he married Elizabeth SALISBURY at Preston Capes on 31 Jan 1920, the banns having been published on 4 Jan, 11 Jan and 18 Jan. After he retired, they moved to Daventry where he died on 29 Sep 1933 at the age of 74. Charles was buried in the churchyard at Preston Capes on 5 Oct.
