**KNIGHTLEY, Valentine**

1812-1898

Fourth Baronet of Fawsley, Valentine was the eldest son of Reverend Henry, Rector of Byfield and Charwelton and Jane Diana KNIGHTLEY (née STORY) and was born at Charwelton on 30 Sep 1812. Upon the death of his father, the following year, his mother moved back to her parent's home at Lockington Hall, Leics where he spent much of his early childhood. Valentine matriculated at Christ Church College, Oxford on 26 Nov 1830 and was awarded a B.A. degree in 1834. Valentine was appointed a deacon on 25 Oct 1835 at Peterborough and received his M.A. at Lambeth in 1837. He was instituted as Rector of Preston Capes on 9 Dec 1836 and of Charwelton on 9 Feb 1837, holding both until his death. He held several business ventures holding shares in partnership in the Union Bank of London. Valentine officiated at the marriage of his cousin Rainald KNIGHTLEY to Louisa Mary BOWATER at Easton Square, London on 20 Oct 1869. He continued to live in the village even after he succeeded to the baronetcy and Fawsley Estate on the death of Lord Rainald KNIGHTLEY of Fawsley on 19 Dec 1895. He refused to be styled "Sir Valentine" preferring to be known as "Old Val". Valentine died on 28 Apr 1898 at the age of 85 and was buried in the churchyard at Preston Capes on 2 May.

- if his great niece Beryl Stopford HICKMAN die without surviving children then her part of the residue to Selina Mary MILLS
- in the case of neither Jane Edith KNIGHTLEY nor Beryl Stopford HICKMAN having any surviving children then the £3000 to be invested and the annual income paid to his brother's widow Mary Maria KNIGHTLEY
