NICOLL, John**1683-1765**

The son of John and Mary NICOLL (née BUTLER), John was born on 6 Nov 1683 and baptised at Preston Capes on 16 Nov. His father died when he was 6 years old and he was brought up by his grandfather, Richard BUTLER. He was elected on a Westminster scholarship to Christ Church College, Oxford on 23 Jun 1704, completed his B.A. degree in 1708 and was awarded his master's degree on 15 Mar 1710. John was ordained a deacon at Christ Church, Oxford on 25 Feb 1711 and a priest on 19 Sep 1714 at Bromley, Kent. He was appointed second master of Westminster School in 1714 and became Rector of Hannington, Hants on 16 Aug 1725 and of Meonstoke, Hants on 16 Sep 1736. On 19 Apr 1733, John was appointed Headmaster of Westminster School, when he was created

a Doctor of Divinity in convocation. He was granted one of the prebendal stalls of Westminster in 1740 and became Canon of Christ Church, Oxford from 1751 until his death. John resigned from Westminster School in 1753. He died on 19 Sep 1765 and was buried in the north transept of Christ Church Cathedral, Oxford on 23 Sep, where a complimentary Latin inscription is placed to his memory. His widow, whose name is not known, was buried in the Cathedral on 25 Jun 1773.

NICOLL, Richard 1733-1813

The son of Thomas and Mary NICOLL (previously HORSEMAN nee MEADES), Richard was baptised at Preston Capes on 29 May 1733 and joined Rugby School in 1743. He matriculated at Lincoln College, Oxford, Oxon on 19 Jun 1750 and was awarded his B.A. degree in 1755, became a Fellow of the College and was awarded his M.A. on 27 Jan 1757. Richard was made a deacon on 5 Jun 1757 at Christchurch, Oxon by Thomas, Bishop of Oxford, and a priest on 24 Dec 1758 also at Christchurch, Oxon, by John, Bishop of Oxford and became a Bachelor of Divinity on 4 Jul 1764. On 7 May 1766, he became Vicar of Preston Deanery but resigned in 1767 when he married Miss Vere WYKEHAM of Broughton Castle, Oxon. On 2 Feb 1770, Richard was appointed Rector of Drayton, Oxon and became a Doctor of Divinity on 24 May 1775. On 27 Oct 1780, he was awarded a dispensation to hold Cherrington, Warks with Drayton and then Abington, Oxon with Drayton on 27 Oct 1783, a position which he resigned in 1792. Richard was instituted as Chancellor of Wells Cathedral on 19 Aug 1786 and Chaplain in Ordination to the King; a post which he resigned in 1804. He exercised his vote in the County Election of Nov 1806 when he voted for Lord Althorp and William CARTWRIGHT. His wife died on 5 Nov 1812 and he died just 2 months later on 20 Jan 1813 at the age of 80. Richard was buried at Bodicote, Oxon on 26 Jan.

Obituary:

At Bodicote, Oxon on 20 Jan 1813, the Rev. Richard NICOLL, D.D. rector of Drayton in that county, chancellor of Wells, and late chaplain in ordinary to his Majesty. This honour he resigned in 1804. Dr. NICOLL was a Divine of the old school, a man of strong parts and an extensive capacity. In literature, his attainments were eminent, embracing in particular every topic of history, sacred and profane, ecclesiastical and secular, connected with the wide range of his profession; whilst a most retentive memory and prompt elocution enabled him to pour forth in exuberance the collected stores of his rich and various knowledge on every subject that presented itself. Hence, although he appeared to great advantage in the pulpit, where the dignity of his figure and the solemnity of his manner, where the excellence of his discourse, and his masculine and energetic delivery, attracted high admiration; yet in the opinion of those who best knew him, his talents seemed peculiarly formed for conversation. In that familiar and constantly recurring exercise of the mental faculties, he shone, indeed, with uncommon brilliance. In an apprehension quick as lightning, in the vivacity of his wit, and the profusion of his anecdote, he had in the judgment of a large circle of acquaintance few equals, and scarcely a superior. But this was the least part of his praise: his fame rested on a much firmer and surer basis than the brightest acquirements, or the most splendid abilities. He was an undissembled Christian, animated with all the genuine benevolence of that noble character. Humane, compassionate, charitable - he delighted in doing good and diffusing happiness; he felt for indigence, sympathized with sorrow, and relieved misery to the utmost limits of his power. In domestic life his character was no less estimable. He was a steady friend, a kind master, the most indulgent of parents; and to her who had been the partner of his cares and his felicity during a period of forty-five years, he was so affectionately devoted, that he regarded her separation from him with a kind of instinctive and unconquerable horror, which sometimes transported him beyond the bounds of moderation: a venial fault, if any could be such, and too manifest an indication that her removal from this life would be the probable harbinger of his own. Nor were these apprehensions without foundation. For though he lingered on from the 5th of November (the time of her death) to the 20th of January; yet through the whole of that interval the lamp of life was evidently wasting with extreme rapidity; and on the morning of that day he happily obtained, by an easy and gentle expiration, his release from the troubles of mortality. *Feminis legere honorem est: viris meminisse*
