**QUINNEY, Ann****1803-1886**

The daughter of Thomas and Jane QUINNEY (née SORRILL), Ann was baptised at Preston Capes on 23 Jan 1803. Her mother died in June that year and after reaching school leaving age, Ann stayed in the village to care for her father until his death in 1841. She left the parish and married Charles AYRES, a labourer, at Everdon on 11 May 1843. Her husband died in 1862 but Ann stayed in Everdon where she initially worked as a housekeeper for a Henry WRIGHT. When the job ended she worked from home as a lacemaker. Ann died in 1886 at the age of 83 and was buried in the churchyard at Everdon on 6 Jun.

She fell ill and moved to the Daventry area where she died in 1895 at the age of 20.

**QUINNEY, Ben** **1871-1956**

The son of William and Emma QUINNEY (née NEAL), Ben was born at Preston Capes in Mar 1871 and baptised at the parish church on 2 Apr. He attended the village school on two occasions, between Feb 1876 and 6 Jul 1880 and again from 23 Oct 1883 after which he found work as a farm labourer. Ben married Elizabeth Lizzie Louisa BILLINGHAM at Maidford in 1898 and moved there in 1902. He returned to Preston Capes about 16 Nov 1905. Ben left the parish in 1937 and moved to Kettering where he died 1956 at the age of 86.

The daughter of Thomas and Ann QUINNEY (née BAILEY), Fanny was born at Preston Capes in 1846 and left the parish about 1864 when she went into service at Everdon for Thomas BURTON. Fanny moved again about 1876 when she worked as a cook for Joseph ROWLAND at Kidlington, Oxon. She moved to Nelson, Lancs where she worked as a housekeeper for a teacher Higham near Burnley, Lancs where she married George HAYTHORNTHWAITE in 1898. Her husband died in 1904 and Fanny worked from home as a baker. Fanny died in Higham, Lancs in 1930 at the age of 84.
