VERNON, Humphrey

~1621-1677

Humphrey was living in Worcestershire at the time of his admission to Emmanuel College, Cambridge on 12 Feb 1638 where he paid for his own accommodation. He was awarded a B. A. degree in 1642 and an M. A. in 1645 when he was also made a Fellow of the college. Humphrey married Helen about this time and was ordained a priest by the Bishop of Kilmore on 5 Feb 1651 and was appointed curate of Highgate, Middx in 1664. He moved to Preston Capes upon his appointment as curate before 26 Feb 1665 and was instituted as Rector on 25 Oct 1667 on the presentation of Lord CREW. Humphrey was buried in the churchyard on 30 Jun 1677.
