The daughter of William and Elizabeth YARNOLD (née MARRIOTT), Annie was born at Saredon, Staffs in 1873 and attended Rose Mount School, Ledbury, Hereford as a boarder. Upon leaving school she moved to Defford, Worcs where she worked as a governess and returned to her parent's home in the mid-1890s who had moved to Leigh Sinton, Worcs. Annie married Frederick WOOD at the parish church there in 1902 and moved to Pickworth, Rutland. They moved to Lutterworth, Leics in 1915 and came to Little Preston about 6 Apr 1935. They left the parish in 1949 and moved to Dodford to live with her daughter Gertrude and her family. Annie died there on 17 Dec 1953 at the age of 79.

**YOULDEN, Abraham**

1794/95-1860

Abraham was born in Spalding, Lincs in 1794/95 and admitted as a sizar at St. Johns College, Cambridge University on 12 Apr 1821 before matriculating at Michaelmas that year. He was awarded a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1825 and was ordained a deacon at the Parochial Chapel of Saint Mary le Bone, London on 29 May 1825 when he became stipendiary curate for Moulton Chapel, Lincs. Abraham was ordained a priest at Buckden, Cambs on 18 Dec 1825. He was appointed as schoolmaster and curate of the parish church at Preston Capes in 1827 and was awarded a Master of Arts degree at St. Johns in 1828. Abraham left the parish upon his marriage to Elizabeth Peach GREEN at Spalding, Lincs on 30 Jul 1835 after which he was appointed Headmaster of Henley on Thames Grammar School, Berks, a position that he held until 1841 when he moved to Beaconsfield, Bucks to become Master of the school and Rector of Hedsor, Bucks. He left the school about 1856 and moved to Taplow, Bucks where he died on 13 Nov 1860. Abraham was buried in the churchyard at Hedsor, Bucks on 17 Nov.
